Overview

Our course is based on industry knowledge and over 10 years of clinical experience. The procedure of Micro-Suction is the safest method for the removal of ear wax, infection and foreign body blockages and is the same preferred technique practiced by Ear Nose & Throat specialist, the Royal Victorian Eye and Ear Hospital and practiced internally by Ear Nurses.

Course content

The training comprises the following 3 units of competency:

Unit 1: MICEAR001A Recognise the anatomy and physiology of the ear, ear conditions and treatment

Unit 2: MICWAX002A Perform wax removal by aural toilet and micro-suction

Unit 3: MICEAU001A Manage, educating and promote aural care

The procedure of Micro-Suction and Aural Hygiene is quite complex, not everyone has the same anatomy & physiology and wax type which is why the course has been designed for the student to be able to acquire maximum exposure to various types of ears and wax conditions over 3 weeks clinical placement.

Outcome

On completion of this course it is expected that participants will be able to:

- Assess the anatomy and physiology of the ear and ear conditions
- Describe how sound waves are transmitted through the ear
- Complete an ear examination and aural health assessment
- Understand the procedure of Micro-Suction and Aural Hygiene
- Use the aural care and micro-suction equipment for the removal of ear wax, foreign bodies and infection effectively
- Determine the type of ear blockage
- Determine abnormalities in the normal physiology of the ear
- Educate patients regarding good aural care
- Examine and treat children
- To communicate with hearing impaired patients and families
- Examine and determine whether patient requires further health care review
- Report findings of ear
- Understand how an ear clinic and ear nurses work

Pre-requisites

The ideal students will be health professionals registered under AHPRA as a Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Audiologist or General Practitioner. Evidence of Registration and Formal Qualification transcripts are required with enrolment documents.
