Designed for experienced Registered Nurses, Clear Ears Course in Aural Care is based on the UK Aural Care Certificate, with permission from the Department of Otolaryngology, Stoke Mandeville Hospital, and adapted to Australian standards with assistance from ENT Surgeons and Audiologists.
